

AVANCED OBEDIENCE ANSWERS

1. take it
2. right hand raised, with palm open, slightly higher than your head (to side not front)
3. if it's too short, the side vision of the dog may be obstructed
4. either pull him by the leash toward the dumbbell or if that frightens him, push his head toward it
5. Send Your Dog
6. far enough so the dog can grasp it with his teeth without touching his nose to the ground
7. give or out
8. 1" more than the width between a dog's eyes
9. rigid, semi-rigid, firm, non-toxic, non-wooden material, similar in size, shape, color, and weight to a wooden dumbbell
10. at least 15'
11. rubber or similar non-slip material
12. command or signal by the handler
13. sit
14. jump or over
15. right
16. 4' high, 5' wide
17. flat white
18. 8"
19. Open A
20. Open A, Open B, Utility A
21. the one without the dumbbell
22. Retrieve Over High Jump
23. five minutes out of sight
24. retrieve on flat; retrieve over high jump; broad jump
25. Heel Free, Figure 8, Drop on Recall, Retrieve on Flat, Broad Jump, Long Sit, Long Down
26. 8'

27. Hand Signal, Scent Discrimination, Retrieve Over High Jump, Broad Jump, Long Sit & Down out of sight
28. Directed Retrieve, Directed Jumping, Signal Exercise, Scent Discrimination, Moving Stand for Exam
29. Directed Retrieve, Directed Jumping, Moving Stand for Exam on command
30. Moving Stand for Exam
31. The handler will, without pausing, command &/or signal the dog to stand, continue forward 10-12' and turn around and face the dog. The dog must stand and stay in position.
32. The dog shall heel, stand, and stay on command by the moving handler. The dog shall also accept the exam without shyness or resentment, and return to the handler on command.
33. mouth or testicles
34. any commands or signals by the handler, after turning, to position the dog to face the designated glove; for not going directly to the designated glove; or for not retrieving the glove
35. 3' from sides and end of ring
36. three white work gloves supplied by the handler
37. The handler will give the dog a single motion of the left hand along the right side of the dog, and will give the command to retrieve either simultaneously with or immediately following the giving of the direction.
38. the dog stays until directed to retrieve; the dog goes directly to the designated glove; the dog promptly retrieves
39. dog and handler work as a team while heeling, and the dog's correct responses to the signals to "stand", "stay", "drop", "sit", and "come"
40. no vocal commands, only signals may be given
41. 40
42. sweep your right hand out sideways and then to your chest
43. Dog fails to do command on first signal or handler gives an audible signal.
44. at the far end of the ring
45. touching them
46. It must return to the handler after first being directed to either jump the broad jump or the bar jump. Upon return it shall sit in front of the handler until the finish command is given.
47. The bar shall be painted a flat black and white in alternate sections of about 3" each (or the bar may be painted totally white and black tape wrapped around it at intervals).

48. 18-20'
49. The dog goes away from the handler in the direction indicated, stops when commanded, jumps as directed, and returns as in the Recall.
50. dog must select by scent alone an article which has been handled by the handler
51. 15', 6"
52. It shall be placed on a table or chair and the second exercise be completed with one less article in the ring.
53. away from the articles
54. by gently touching the dog's nose with the palm of one open hand while the dog is sitting at heel
55. leather and metal, five of each
56. judge or steward
57. the handler
58. 30
